

The Commission approved the following draft resolution at its special session held in Amman, on 8 June 2015, and is presenting it for consideration and action by the Economic and Social Council.

Draft resolution

**Admission of Mauritania as a member of the Economic and Social Commission
for Western Asia**

The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia,

Referring to the letter addressed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation of Mauritania to the secretariat of the Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia on 30 April 2015, in which it expressed the interest of Mauritania in becoming a member of the Commission,

Recalling the accession of the Sudan to the Commission in 2008 as per Economic and Social Council resolution 2008/8 of 22 July 2008, and the accession of Libya, Morocco and Tunisia to the Commission in 2012 as per Economic and Social Council resolution 2012/1 of 10 July 2012,

Recalling also its resolution 302 (XXVII) of 10 May 2012, which invites all Arab countries to become members of the Commission,

1. *Welcomes* the request of Mauritania to become a member of the Commission;
2. *Recommends* that the Economic and Social Council approve the admission of Mauritania as a member of the Commission;
3. *Requests* the Executive Secretary of the Commission to follow up on the implementation of the present resolution.
